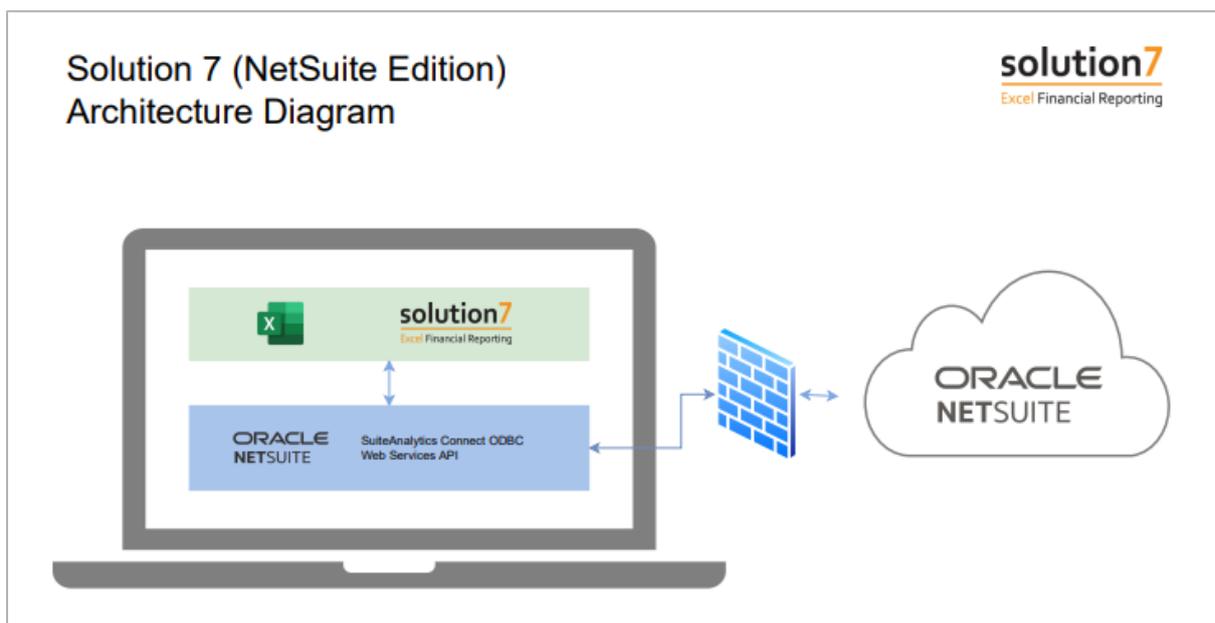
Introduction

A firewall protects your network or computer from unwanted internet traffic. Its primary function is to let good traffic pass and block unwanted or bad traffic. This document explains the firewall and proxy settings necessary to allow Solution 7 to successfully communicate with NetSuite.

Solution 7 Architecture

Solution 7 connects to NetSuite using NetSuite SuiteAnalytics Connect. Connections are secured by the SuiteAnalytics Connect ODBC driver to prevent possible data interception via man-in-the-middle attacks.

No data is transmitted via Solution 7 infrastructure or stored on Solution 7 servers.



NetSuite IP Addresses

NetSuite does not support the use of NetSuite IP addresses to access or manage access to any NetSuite services. **IP addresses of NetSuite services may change at any time without notice.**

Managing Access to NetSuite Services

If you are programming a firewall for your company's outbound requests (inbound to NetSuite) please allow *.netsuite.com to enable all entry points and open the following ports:

- Port **80** for non-secure HTTP pages.
- Port **443** for secure HTTPS pages.
- Port **1708** for SuiteAnalytics Connect access.

Account-specific service URLs

If you would prefer to use account-specific service URLs, these can be found within NetSuite by logging onto NetSuite as an Administrator and navigating to **Setup -> Company Information -> Company URLs**. Example account-specific service URLs can also be found below:
